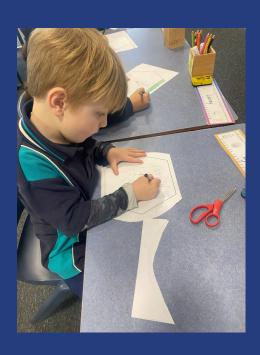

In my role as Child Safe Advocate (CSA) I am responsible for ensuring that the Child Safe Standards are upheld in our school. During my most recent professional learning day in Canberra, we looked at the guidelines around visitors and volunteers to the service and the importance of policies and procedures for this area.

Ideas to add more vegetables

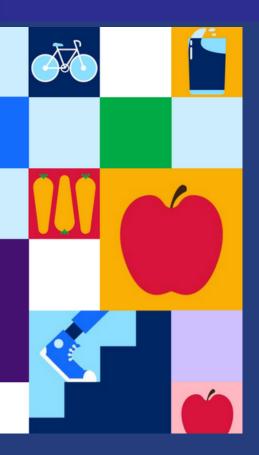

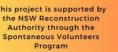

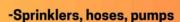
